basketball game were included. It was a great night out for families, and the kids loved testing all the different pizzas, and then voting for their favorite.

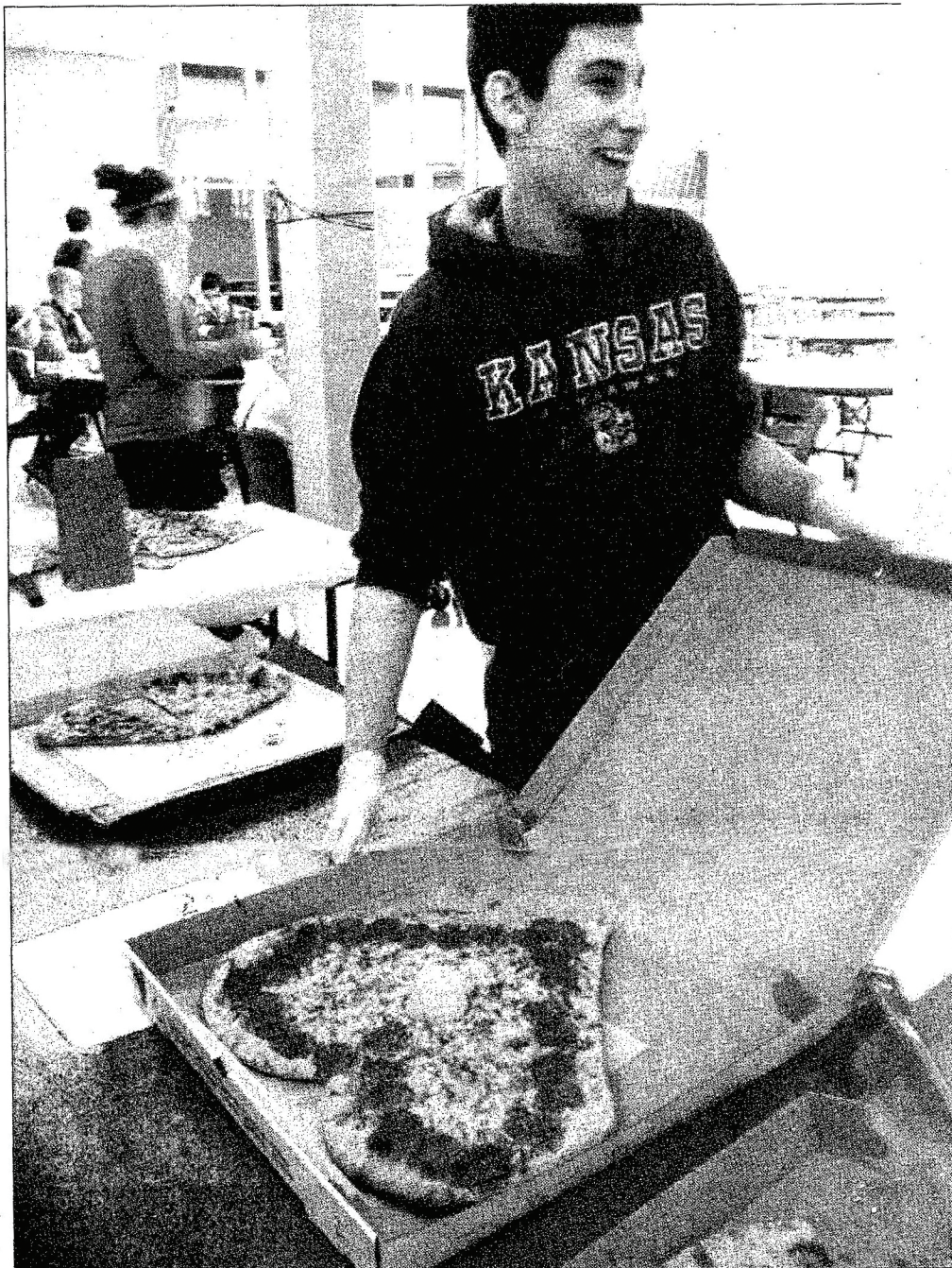
